#### LISNDA Coop 2024-2025 Bids

#### Each addendum must be initialed below and returned as part of the vendor's submission.

1. Kitchen Equipment and Supplies Bid:

KE11519, Oven, conv: Blodgett Convection Oven SH0 100G is DC, replaced by Zeph-100\_G- DBL

- 2. Approved alternate items:
  - a. Requests were received for brand approval for items that had no approved brand listed, or a Distributor's Choice item. The coop is only requiring prior approval for items that had a specific approved brand, and the vendor is requesting an alternate.
  - b. Some requests were received for items that did have a specific brand listed. The bid chairs have received these requests and should any items be approved, appropriate notification will be given.

## 3. Responses to questions:

I am looking at the Snack Bid and starting on Page 10 there is Appendix A- sample contract. Do we need to do anything with this as it's a sample? It looks to run from page 10 through page 12 and requires a signature on the last page, page 13. I have not seen this in previous years' bids.

The sample contract is provided for informational purposes only. It does not have to be returned with submissions. The actual contract may differ slightly from the sample. This applies to all bids.

### Can we offer alternate items after the deadline of April 19?

No, the deadline for offering alternate items was closed 2 weeks prior to the bid opening as stated in the Terms and Conditions.

On the non-compliant snack bid there is a Certification of Compliance for Federally funded procurement. Since this does not apply to us do I leave the page out, leave it blank, or just draw a line through it striking that page?

The Certification of Compliance for Federally Funded Procurement needs to be returned with all responses and Federal dollars may be used by the districts for purchases.
